SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE RECOMMENDED OR REQUIRED BY THEIR TEACHER.

- Required students are students who failed a subject or two subject(s). There are three ways to make up the failures so as not to repeat the grade, and is explained on the form sent home. All suggestions should be a total of approximately 75 hours.
 1. Attending the morning session of 6 weeks GSA Summer School program which runs in conjunction with our Summer Fun program. (Explained on form sent home)
 2. Private Tutoring or formal tutoring programs.
 3. Attending another Certified Summer School program. Providing documentation of completion of program.
- Recommended students are students who would benefit greatly from a structured program of a total of approximately 50 hours.
 1. Attending the morning session of 4 weeks GSA Summer School program which runs in conjunction with our Summer Fun program. (Explained on form sent home)
 2. Private tutoring.
 3. Attending formal small tutoring groups.

EXPLANATION OF NEW FINANCIAL COLLECTION BY SMART TUITION

Your Smart Tuition invoice will include an itemized list of Tuition and all Fees.

- **When you log into your account**, simply check on the **Monthly Payment Amount**, and you will see **the breakdown**.
- **Calendar Raffle Bond** – The \$400.00 will be billed from August to November at \$100.00 per month. If this is paid in full, **you will not have to send** the \$400.00 with your Raffle Tickets. This amount will be applied to your sales.
- **HSA Service Hours** – The \$200.00 will be applied July – April at \$20 per month. This amount will be refunded in June 2018 if all ten HSA service hours are completed as per the Commitment Letter.
