Why the State Budget Matters to Our Families:

The Governor's Fiscal Year 2017 Budget cut funding for nonpublic school programs by 6.8%

- ◆ Nonpublic School Security Program was totally eliminated
- ◆ Per Pupil amounts for Nursing Services and Technology were reduced.
- ◆ Per Pupil amount for Nonpublic School Transportation remained frozen at \$884.00 - an amount that has been frozen for nine years.

These losses directly affect our children and mean that we will have to do more with less or go without next year.
