TEAM RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Players are expected to show up for practice and games on time.
- 2. Players and/or parents **must** call, text or e-mail if a player will miss practice or a game or plans to be late for practice or a game.
- 3. Players will bring the following during practices and games:
 - Regulation kneepads (recommended)
 - Regulation indoor volleyball (**optional**) only during practices
 - Bottle water or sport drink labeled with your child's name (highly recommended)
- 4. Players are to keep cell phones packed away during all practices and games.
- 5. Players are expected to be respectful to the Coaches and follow all directions given by the Coaches.
- 6. Players are expected to show a positive attitude. There will be no whining, grumbling, horse-play, or other disruptive acts during practices and/or games.
- 7. Players are expected to be courteous towards teammates at all times. There will be no name- calling, teasing, criticizing or other acts designed to hurt feelings or cause injury.
- 8. All players must arrive **30 minutes** before game time in order to do warm-ups, stretches and to obtain game lineups. If you can't make the game, please call as soon as possible.
- 9. No jewelry, watches, bracelets (of any kind), earrings, chains can be worn during a games and practices. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back during games and practices.

- 10. Players must wear proper uniform during games unless instructed by coach.
- 11. **During games,** players and parents are expected to be courteous and respectful to our opponents and referee. Do not bait or taunt opponents. Remember you are representing Good Shepherd Academy.
- 12. Any player ejected from a game because of unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from the next game and may be subject to additional penalties.
- 13. Any player who physically and/or verbally abuses another player, participating or official may be suspended from play for the remainder of the season and may be disqualified from Archdiocesan sports competition.
- 14. Players and parents are expected to help with set up and clean up for all home games.
- 15. Players are responsible for completing all homework and maintain good grades.

Rules and Expectations for Parents

- 16. Remember that the players are children and are playing for their enjoyment. Make no derogatory comments or gestures to players, coaches, other parents and any member of the opposing team. Keep it positive.
- 17. Parents remember: Let the Players play, Coaches coach and Referees ref. The decision of the referee is binding, so don't whine over a bad call. Let the Coaches handle what happens on the Court.
- 18. **Parents please no sideline coaching during the games**. This is a distraction to the children and it's in contradiction of what the coaches are trying to accomplish with them. Just be the best cheerleaders you can be.
- 19. Each player must have a high school age or older individual (i.e. parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle, sister, or brother) on a rotating basis, help out with admission, concessions and line judging at the games.

20. Failure to follow Team Rules and Expectations may result in appropriate disciplinary actions.
