DRESS CODE POLICY 2019-2020

Good Shepherd Academy students take pride in wearing their uniforms as a sign of their love and dedication to the educational mission of the academy. They have the opportunity to wear an OFFICIAL WINTER AND SUMMER UNIFORM which is purchased from FLYNN O'HARA UNIFORM COMPANY, either online or in uniform stores located in Newark and Parsippany, NJ. All transactions take place directly with Flynn O'Hara Uniforms since they know all the items needed. The uniform is mandatory.

THE OFFICIAL WINTER UNIFORM is worn the first full week of November through the last full week of April. (See monthly school calendar for exact start date)

THE OFFICIAL SPRING/FALL UNIFORM is worn from the first full week of May through the last full week of October. (See monthly school calendar for exact start date)

PRE-K - Boys and Girls Winter Uniform - Navy sweat pants, blue polo shirt, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy micromesh shorts, blue polo shirt or ash gray gym shirt, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

KINDERGARTEN - Boys Winter Uniform - Navy pants, white banded bottom shirt, black oxford tie shoes, navy ankle quarter crew socks. (No tie; no belt)

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy shorts, white banded bottom shirt, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

GRADES K-5 - Girls Winter Uniform - Navy plaid jumper, white Peterpan collar blouse (long or short sleeves), optional GSA navy cardigan sweater (no other sweatshirt or sweater may be worn) or navy uniform slacks, white Peterpan collar blouse (long or short sleeves) with *mandatory* navy sweater vest, *optional* GSA navy cardigan sweater may be worn over vest, black Mary Jane strap shoe, navy knee socks or navy tights.

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy shorts, white banded bottom shirt only, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

GRADES 6-8 - Girls Winter Uniform - Navy flat front pants/navy flat front mid-rise pants or navy pleat skort, white button down collar blouse (long or short sleeves), mandatory navy sweater vest with slacks or skort, *optional* GSA navy cardigan sweater may be worn over vest (no other sweatshirt or sweater may be worn even if it includes the GSA logo), black penny loafer uniform shoe, navy knee socks. **Please note:** GSA fleece jacket is considered an outerwear garment and is not a part of the official uniform.

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy skort, white banded bottom shirt only, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

GRADES 1-8 - Boys Winter Uniform - Navy pants, black/brown reversible belt, white button down collar shirt (long or short sleeves), school tie (grades 1-5 plaid tie; grades 6-8 navy pattern tie), *mandatory* navy vest, *optional* GSA navy cardigan sweater may be worn over vest (no other sweatshirt or sweater may be worn), black tie shoes, navy ankle quarter crew socks.

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy shorts, short sleeve white banded bottom shirt, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

GYM UNIFORM - GRADES K-8 - Boys and Girls

Navy sweat pants, ash gray sweatshirt or tee shirt with school emblem, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers. No jewelry is to be worn during gym class.

Spring/Fall Uniform - Navy shorts, ash gray tee shirt with school emblem, white ankle quarter crew socks, plain white sneakers.

ACCESSORIES

The following are **NOT** permitted (including, but not limited to): nail polish, long finger nails, make-up, hair coloring, oversized bows, headbands with ears or items which distract, dangling or hoop earrings, nose rings, tongue rings, plugs, tattoos, ornamental jewelry, hats, or high heel shoes. **NO** flip flops or hats may be worn inside the school building. Boys' hair length may not be below the top of the uniform shirt collar, dyed, ponytails, braids or any trendy hair style.

Please note: Backpacks with wheels are no longer permitted effective September 4, 2019.
